Nav Srishti, in collaboration with Child Rights and You, organized a four-day theatre workshop at Neb Sarai, New Delhi, with 40 children from Faridabad. Conducted by the Mehak Delhi Theatre Group, the workshop trained children in theatre techniques and focused on plays highlighting child labour and child marriage. It was inaugurated by Mrs. Reena Banerjee, who spoke on theatre's role in social change. The event concluded with children's performances, certificate distribution, and closing remarks of gratitude.





Independence Day was joyfully celebrated at all our Nav Srishti centres along with the children from the crèche and balwadi. The programme began with the national anthem, followed by vibrant dance performances, the hoisting of the national flag, and a lively balloon dance that filled the atmosphere with excitement.

An oral cancer screening camp was held under the Sakushal Sarthi Health Camp at MS Transport, Punjabi Bagh, New Delhi, with support from Rajiv Gandhi Cancer Institute & Research Centre. The camp aimed to raise awareness about oral cancer risks, provide free screenings for early detection, and refer suspected cases for further care. The screening included visual oral examinations, risk assessments, and counseling on prevention. A total of 83 individuals were screened, promoting early diagnosis and improved health outcomes.





Nav Srishti participated in a two-day consultation hosted by the SNEHA Knowledge Centre with NGOs, funders, academics, and public system partners to strengthen GBV (Gender-Based Violence) prevention efforts in India. The consultation focused on understanding effective prevention strategies, exploring interventions, defining success, and developing metrics to measure impact. Prevention was emphasized as the key to achieving long-term systemic change and building safer, more equitable communities.

On August 28, 2025, Nav Srishti visited Government Girls Senior Secondary School, Prem Nagar, Delhi, where we conducted an awareness session on missing children.

During the session, we explained preventive measures that students can take to protect themselves and their younger siblings, as well as the steps to follow in case a child goes missing. Information about the child helpline number was also shared.

A total of 200 girls actively participated in the session.
