Batch 2601, the first Retail Training Program batch of 2026–27, was conducted from 5 May to 6 June 2026. The program enhanced the employability of young women through industry-relevant skills training, practical exposure, and employment opportunities in the retail sector.

An Exposure Visit to Shoppers Stop was organized on 1 June 2026 to provide trainees with first-hand experience of a professional retail environment. The visit offered valuable insights into customer service standards, visual merchandising, inventory management, and day-to-day store operations, helping trainees gain a better understanding of industry expectations.





We successfully organized a Health Check-up Camp at Indian Oil Corporation Limited on behalf of the Apollo Tyres Health Care Centre. Our team provided health screenings and medical consultations for truck drivers, covering HIV/AIDS, diabetes, eye health, tuberculosis, and general wellness.

More than 150 truck drivers benefited from the camp. To promote awareness about HIV/AIDS and TB, we conducted interactive games, engaging Q&A sessions, and distributed gifts to participants for their enthusiastic involvement.

Nav Srishti participated in a consultation on the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, organized by the Surya Foundation.

The consultation focused on the theme “One Class, One Book.” During the meeting, detailed discussions were held on the proposed book being developed under this initiative, including its content, relevance, and potential impact on the education system.

Participants shared their views and suggestions, which will contribute to strengthening the book and facilitating its implementation in line with the objectives of NEP 2020.





Nav Srishti had the privilege of hosting 18 interns from the Delhi State Legal Services Authority (DSLISA), as part of the Summer Internship Programme 2026 in Sangam Vihar.

The interns visited the Legal Aid Clinic to gain practical exposure to community-based legal services. During the visit, they were oriented on the functioning of legal aid clinics, access to justice initiatives, and the role of the Mahila Panchayat in supporting women.
